Controlling your data isn't what it used to be


On-premises and cloud-based apps and data are accessed by managed and unmanaged devices. This makes it tough to know who's doing what with your data when it leaves the private data center or cloud.

Ransomware can compromise any endpoint

Any connected smartphone, tablet or laptop can introduce ransomware to your infrastructure. Attackers increasingly target mobile users with spearphishing because it's easier to scam victims who don't have endpoint security.

Attackers are disguised as employees

Using phishing attacks to steal employee credentials, attackers have free rein to spread throughout your infrastructure completely unnoticed.
